

PIPE SMOKING CAUSES CANCER CLAIMS DOCTOR

CHICAGO, Tuesday.

Doctor Bernard Widman, a prominent cancer specialist, said yesterday he believed that pipe smoking helped to cause cancer of the lip.

In an article appearing in the "American Journal of Roentgenology and Radium Therapy," a journal for physicians specialising in X-Ray and radium — Dr. Widman said that at least 40 per cent of the 363 cases of cancer of the lip he had studied had been primarily caused by pipe smoking.

He said doctors had been able to cure 83 per cent of patients who were adequately treated. He added that of the 363 cases he treated only four were women.
